History	C/O fever with reduced appetite since 1 month.

Findings:

LUNG PARENCHYMA:	Unremarkable
MEDIASTINUM AND HILA:	There are multiple, enlarged non-enhancing rounded lymphnodes seen in the right paratracheal retrocaval, retrotracheal, aorto pulmonary window, Hila and subcarinal regions.
CHEST WALL AND PLEURA:	The visualized chest wall and pleural spaces are unremarkable.
HEART AND PERICARDIUM:	Unremarkable
AIRWAY:	The trachea and the main bronchi do not reveal any intrinsic lesion.
AXILLA:	The visualized axilla on either side is normal.
LIVER:	Unremarkable.
GALL BLADDER:	Unremarkable
KIDNEYS:	Unremarkable
ADRENALS:	Unremarkable
PANCREAS:	Unremarkable
<u>OTHER</u>	None.

Impression	<p>The CT Scan features are suggestive of multiple, enlarged non-enhancing lymphnodes in the right paratracheal retrocaval, retrotracheal, aorto pulmonary window, subcarinal and bilateral hilar regions.</p> <p>This is not specific for a single etiology. Possibilities to be considered are :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Infective etiology like tuberculosis. • Lymphoreticular disorders like lymphoma. <p>Advise biopsy.</p>
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
